# International mobility France / Germany similarities


Similarities in the field of higher education and international mobility policies

- Implementation of the Bologna declaration
- Promotion of Master and PhD programs

   and of programs Taught in English

   (1000 Master in Germany; 600 programs in France)
- Initiatives to better welcome students










# International mobility France and Germany organizations are complementary

- The new CampusFrance entity should be similar to DAAD in terms of size and scope of projects







   in 2012, will take place in the United States












#### **Co-operation of external units**
